Pandy's Meadowlands Selections for Saturday, March 7

Note: My odds-line for my top four contenders is based on what I think each horse's chances are to win the race. For instance, if I make a horse 4-1, I think the horse's chances of winning are about 20%, so if the same exact race was run ten times, he'd win it twice. If I make all of the horses about the same odds, that's an indication that I think the race is wide open, or, I'm not sure which horse or horses really has a significant edge.

RACE 1 3 SPORTS VISION 4-1 7 TAILGUNNER HANOVER 5-2 9 ATOMIC REI 4-1 4 DRAMATIC POINT 8-1

SPORTS VISION has some speed and draws inside of main rivals...TAILGUNNER HANOVER may try leaving this time...ATOMIC REI rarely shows speed but fits well here if Gingras can get him into the race...DRAMATIC POINT was bet down as a lot of punters thought he'd improve 2nd off the layoff in last but he finished last; hard to gauge as it's been a couple of years since he showed anything.

RACE 2 2 PIERCEWAVE HANOVER** 2-1 4 CHIEF JUSTICE 7-2 3 LASA DIDA LADY 7-2 6 CYCLONE MAXIMUS 5-1

PIERCEWAVE HANOVER drops for good barn and picks up Callahan.

RACE 3 5 CAPTAIN TREVOR 8-5 1 STENDAHL HANOVER 2-1 7 SAMS A CHAMP A 5-1 4 LIVE ON 5-1

CAPTAIN TREVOR drops off a good effort...STENDAHL HANOVER drops to a level where he should be the one to catch...SAMS A CHAMP A is 2nd off the bench, raced pretty well in return at Freehold and may be worth a price here...LIVE ON seems better than last.

RACE 4 5 COVERED BRIDGE 7-5 8 SINTRA 2-1 4 BELL I NO 4-1 1 WESTERN JOE 9-1

COVERED BRIDGE was raging with pace in his first two U.S. starts...SINTRA is a win machine coming off a layoff and moving into the Burke barn. He took his mark of 1:47.2 over this track and the last time he lost he finished a solid 2nd behind a horse you may have heard of, Mcwicked...BELL I NO is fast and fit but meets two tough foes here...WESTERN JOE hasn't raced since November 23 and this is a tough spot off the bench.

RACE 5 1 THE DEVILS OWN N 1-1 9 STONEDUST 7-2 7 JK WILL POWER 6-1 2 VETTEL N 9-1

THE DEVILS OWN N looked good winning last, which was his U.S. debut...STONEDUST remains in good form...JK WILL POWER never got into the action in a tough field in last; handles this track well and it wouldn't surprise me if driver Pat Berry, who has been the longshot king this meet, engineered one of his crafty upset drive with this \$781,000 earner...VETTEL N makes his 2nd start for JBon and can improve.

RACE 6 4 NASCAR SEELSTER 4-1 5 ROUGH ODDS 2-1 3 UNCLE REIMUS 5-1 2 WESTERN REDHOT 5-1

NASCAR SEELSTER gets a better post, Tetrick is back in the bike, can upset...ROUGH ODDS steps up but his form is solid and this is a prime spot third off the layoff...UNCLE REIMUS fits here on one of his better efforts...WESTERN REDHOT best needed.

RACE 7 7 TALBOTCREEK WHISKEY** 2-1 10 HAYDEN HANOVER 2-1 4 DA MAGICIAN 4-1 3 MITCH MAGUIRE N 8-1

TALBOTCREEK WHISKEY drops out of a tough field, gets a better post for Burke/Gingras...HAYDEN HANOVER classy horse also drops and is the one to beat despite the post...DA MAGICIAN was used hard parked to the half in last and held gamely; meets a stronger group so best is needed...MITCH MAGUIRE N seems better than last.

RACE 8 7 MISTER OHANZEE A 9-1 5 TRUMP THAT 9-2 8 JACK'S SHADOW N 7-5 1 INCREDIBLE SHARK 9-1

MISTER OHANZEE A had a tough spot in his return at Dover; ships in for a top barn...TRUMP THAT can work out a trip for Gingras...JACK'S SHADOW N comes off a sharp win against similar...INCREDIBLE SHARK chased and held the show in a quick mile in last.

RACE 9 7 HURRICANE EMPEROR 6-5 5 ACTOR HANOVER 3-1 4 A MAJOR OMEN 4-1 8 J M MANDAMIN 5-1

HURRICANE EMPEROR has always shown ability but had some problems last year and had to stop after the Meadowlands pace; qualified nicely and may be too fast for these...ACTOR HANOVER finished well in last and he is 2nd off the layoff here.

RACE 10 2 MR HEAVEN 4-1 4 MATEO 2-1 6 TEST RIDE 9-2 1 BUCKEYE IN CHARGE 10-1 RACE 11 3 DEALER'S TABLE 2-1 5 WES DELIGHT 2-1 7 SEEING EYE SINGLE 4-1 4 MAJOR POCKET A 6-1

DEALER'S TABLE drops and picks up Tetrick...WES DELIGHT hasn't raced in a year and a half but qualified nicely for a top barn and he has backclass...SEEING EYE SINGLE beaten favorite in his last two starts, best needed...MAJOR POCKET A had a tough trip in U.S. debut.
