

Pandy's Meadowlands Selections for Saturday, February 6

Note: My odds-line for my top four contenders is based on what I think each horse's chances are to win the race. For instance, if I make a horse 4-1, I think the horse's chances of winning are about 20%, so if the same exact race was run ten times, he'd win it twice. If I make all of the horses about the same odds, that's an indication that I think the race is wide open, or that I can't pinpoint a horse that appears to have a strong edge.

RACE 1

- 4 SWEET ROCK 9-1
- 5 INCREDIBLE SHARK 5-2
- 6 LIKE CLOCKWORK 7-2
- 7 GRIFFON HANOVER 14-1

SWEET ROCK veteran gets a better spot and may have a shot at a price here...INCREDIBLE SHARK steps up off a win, has the class to handle these and the tactical speed to work out a trip...LIKE CLOCKWORK also steps up off a win...GRIFFON HANOVER returns from Yonkers and he handles this track very well.

RACE 2

- 5 CENTURY FURY 4-1
- 1 MCMIKE 5-2
- 3 ALWAYS AND AGAIN 5-2
- 3 WYATT J 4-1

CENTURY FURY finished well from a tough spot in last at Yonkers, two back was a handy first over win...MCMIKE ships in for Burke with class relief...ALWAYS AND AGAIN has struggled to win but his form is rock solid...WYATT J finished gamely in his local debut and adds even more intrigue to this competitive race.

RACE 3

- 1 OURLITTLEGENERAL A
- 6 SADIQ HANOVER 7-5
- 3 GENERAL JOY A 6-1
- 7 IN A SINGLE BOUND 6-1

OURLITTLEGENERAL A gets the call off the drop into a weak field...SADIQ HANOVER looks like the one to beat off the drop here but will probably be too short of a price to offer any value, especially since he's never done much over this track.

RACE 4

- 3 IM A GIGOLO N 5-2
- 2 UNIQUE BEACH 5-2
- 5 GENIUS MAN 4-1
- 7 BIG CITY BUD 4-1

IM A GIGOLO N finished 2nd behind a good horse against multiple winners two back then was an easy winner at this level, albeit against a weaker field than this; late blooming 5 year old seems to have some upside for top barn...UNIQUE BEACH was bet down to 3/5 off a layoff and was used hard setting the pace; should be tougher here...GENIUS MAN ships in from Yonkers off a race he needed...BIG CITY BUD is a competitive sort in good form.

RACE 5

3 PATERNITY SUIT A 4-1
5 IMA REAL LADYS MAN 4-1
9 GODS SPIRIT N 8-1
1 DEALER'S TABLE 9-2

PATERNITY SUIT A gets a better post and may be some value in a wide open race...IMA REAL LADYS MAN was used hard on the lead in last; gets a better post and romped two back...GODS SPIRIT raced okay off a 6 month layoff in last and now gets Dexter Dunn in the bike for good barn. I don't have stats on this, but based on observation, I would venture to guess that first time Dunn has been the best driver change in the sport for the past two years. This guy's hands should be insured by Lloyd's Of London.

BUCK DANCER had post 9 and was a game 2nd behind classy JL CRUZE in last...STORMY KROMER has only raced here once and has been a small track specialist but he's a fast trotter who's capable of a big mile...JL CRUZE is remarkable as he's now 10 years old and still racing at a pretty high level...RICH AND MISERABLE comes off an improved effort second off the bench and we all know what he's capable of.

1 BRIGADOON 9-2
9 RUTHLESS DUDE 8-1

REGGIANO was one of my Best Bets last week but he suffered broken equipment early in the race last week, still finished strongly for the place...FOREVERNALWAYS is in good form, barn is going well, Dunn is in the bike...BRIGADOON loses Dunn but gets Gingras off a good effort...RUTHLESS DUDE was a nice overlay at 19-1 last week. I picked him second and I did bet him at those odds. He gets a tougher post here but might be able to leave again for live barn.

CUE HALL takes a key drop...EXPLOSIVE RIDGE has won two in a row since the claim...HENDERSON SEELSTER holds his solid form...PIKACHU HANOVER came back off a layoff with a nice win; steps up but this lightly raced 7 year old should be sharper tonight.
