I've now hit the Pick 4 seven times in the first two and a half months of the year, which is a high percentage considering that I only hit it eight times all of last year, albeit in a shortened racing year because of the virus. I hit the Pick 4 eight times last year, a solid year with a nice profit, with the best hit on Friday, March 6, nice payoff, \$555.45 for the \$24.00 wager on 50 cent tickets. Meet record for year ending 2020: 54 pick fours, 8 won, 46 lost, plus \$885.30.

Current (2021) meet record: 21 pick fours, 7 won, 14 lost, plus \$174.40.

## **Analysis:**

Race 6: Pikachu Hanover and Kenziesky Hanover are the two obvious contenders here.

**Race 7:** Lyons King could be tough here as he was facing better at Yonkers and had a brutal trip from post 7 in last. But I'm also using Saying Grace N and Stonedust.

**Race 8:** Deltasun A is the one to beat but I still think that Henderson Seelster can upset if he can mind his manners, and Patriarch Hanover returns for top connections.

Race 9: Chief Justice drops and gets a better spot. Halo Its Me comes off a solid placing.
