

**Pandy's Meadowlands \$0.50 cent Pick 4 (15% takeout and \$50,000 Guaranteed Pool),
Saturday, May 15**

I hit the Pick 4 last Saturday night and it paid \$201.60 but I had it for a buck for a return of \$403.20 on a \$42.00 ticket. I've hit the Pick 4 twelve times this year, four more than my entire total for last year (albeit in a shortened season). I hit the Pick 4 eight times last year, a solid year with a nice profit, with the best hit on Friday, March 6, nice payoff, \$555.45 for the \$24.00 wager on 50 cent tickets. Meet record for year ending 2020: 56 pick fours, 9 won, 47 lost, plus \$1228.50.

Current (2021) meet record: 35 pick fours, 11 won, 24 lost, plus \$282.05

Tonight's tickets:

\$0.50 cent play: $3456/1247/56/369 = \$48.00$

\$0.50 cent play: $4/4/56/369 = \$3.00$

Analysis:

Race 6: Wide open race to start the Pick 4. I think that Lyons Sentinel could go a big mile second off the bench but on my main ticket, I'm using all four of my listed contenders, 3, 4, 5, 6.

Race 7: Lovedbythemasses is sharp and is my Best Bet as I look for value but this is definitely a wide open trot so on my main ticket I'm using four, 1, 2, 4, 7.

Race 8: Another competitive race but to keep the cost down I'm going to try two, Warrawee Vital, second off the layoff, and Captain Barbossa, who looks for this third straight.

Race 9: This race is wide open unless you think that Manchego will outclass them (but she had a fever recently and has missed time). I'm going to try all four of my listed contenders, 3, 6, 7, 9.
