PELLING: "HE'S QUALIFYING TUESDAY [MAY 17] AT PHILLY. HE AND ALLYWAG [HANOVER] TRAINED QUICKLY [TUESDAY] AND FINISHED TOGETHER. HANK IS DOING WELL NOW. TIMMY [TETRICK] WAS VERY HAPPY WITH HIM THE OTHER DAY. MOORE LOOKS FOR A SECOND STRAIGHT MEADOWLANDS PACE WIN AFTER TAKING LAST YEAR'S EDITION WITH LAWLESS SHADOW. MOORE: "HE'S HAD ONLY SIX LIFETIME STARTS BUT WAS VERY IMPRESSIVE SATURDAY. HE'S OVERCOME A LOT OF ADVERSITY. HE'S HAD BONE CHIP SURGERY IN BOTH HOCKS AND ONE ANKLE. AND IN THE LAST FEW WEEKS, HE'S HAD TROUBLE TYING UP. BUT HE'S OK NOW. TAKTER: "HE HAD POST NINE AND HE WENT A LITTLE FAST ON THE TURN. I'M NOT REALLY CONCERNED ABOUT IT. HE BROKE IN THE SAME EXACT SPOT LAST YEAR AS A 2-YEAR-OLD. WE MADE SOME ADJUSTMENTS. BROWN: "FOR HIS FIRST START, IT WAS GOOD ENOUGH. HE CAME FIRST UP DOWN THE BACKSTRETCH.
