

**Pandy's Meadowlands \$0.50 cent Pick 4 (15% takeout, \$50,000 guaranteed pool) Friday, May 5**

Friday, April 28, my regular picks were hot with 8 winners On Top in the 14 races including a \$27.40 winner, and my \$16.00 Pick 4 ticket hit for \$76.90. On Saturday I had three out of four, minus \$20.00. My \$24 ticket hit Saturday, April 1, and paid \$93.15. I hit for \$220.55 and \$196.80 on the two other winning Pick 4's so far this year.

2023: 27 Pick Fours, 4 won, 23 lost, minus \$40.75

Saturday, December 3, I spent more than I usually do, \$72.00 total on two tickets, because I thought it was an interesting sequence, and my \$67.50 bigger ticket hit the Pick 4 for \$744.35. My Best Bet, Big Chic Magnet, was one of the winners and it paid \$16.80. Friday night, June 3, my \$36.00 ticket hit for \$686.20 as veteran trotter JL Cruze really helped as my top pick, paying \$20.20 (he should have been around 2-1). Saturday night, February 19, I hit the Pick 4 on a \$36.00 ticket and it paid \$1113.05.

Final record for 2022: 78 Pick Fours, 13 won, 65 lost, plus \$1753.00.

I hit the Pick 4 twenty one times in 2021. Final 2021 record: 92 pick fours, 21 won, 71 lost, plus \$240.60. I hit the Pick 4 eight times in 2020, a solid year with a nice profit. Meet record for year ending 2020: 54 pick fours, 8 won, 46 lost, plus \$885.30.

Tonight's tickets:

\$0.50 cent ticket: 135/35,10/29/2458 = \$36.00

\$0.50 cent ticket: 135/10/9/2458 = \$6.00

**Race 6:** This is pretty wide open. I'm going to use three, 1, 3, 5.

**Race 7:** I guess you could single dropdown Hot Mess Express, the 10, but I'm going try to get some value with 3, 5, 10 on my main ticket. On another ticket, I'm using two singles.

**Race 8:** I'm going to try and narrow this down. I think Deliciousstone DK can wire these if he can stay flat but Distance Learning raced well off the layoff in last and I'll use him as well, but single the 9 on a separate ticket.

**Race 9:** This is a wide open race with amateur drivers so I'll use all four of my listed contenders, 2, 4, 5, 8.
