Ms. Crissman-Bier's employment of a caretaker who is not licensed by the New Jersey Racing Commission while on the grounds of a facility licensed by and under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Racing Commission is in direct violation of N.J.A.C. 13:71-7.26(d), which states: It shall be the responsibility of the trainer to insure that only individuals licensed by the New Jersey Racing Commission are employed in any capacity of caretaker, groom or other attendant with respect to the care-custody and training of such horse. POSITIVE TEST- POST RACE

James Dunn was the programmed trainer of the horse "Western Stepp" when she raced in the 13th race at the Meadowlands Racetrack on January 19, 2024. Following the race, "Western Stepp" was selected to submit post-race blood and urine samples for analysis. A report from Industrial Laboratories identified the presence of Phenylbutazone above the allowable limits. Mr. Dunn has waived his right to have split sample testing performed and also has waived his right to a hearing before the Board of Judges. James Dunn will be issued a full suspension of his New Jersey Racing Commission license for a period of fifteen (15) days and is also fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. Said suspension shall begin on February 15, 2024 and run through and including February 29, 2024 inclusive. During the period of suspension, Mr. Dunn is denied all access to all grounds that are under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Racing Commission for any and all purposes. Consistent with N.J.A.C. 13:71-23.7 the horse "Western Stepp" is hereby disqualified from sharing in the purse from the 13th race on January 19, 2024. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:71-23.7, the purse monies earned by the horse "Western Stepp" on January 19, 2024 are ordered to be held pending the timely filing of an appeal. Should an appeal be filed, the purse monies earned by the horse "Western Stepp" on January 19, 2024 shall be held pending a final decision by the New Jersey Racing Commission. Should no appeal be filed in accordance with N.J.A.C. 13:71-3.4, the purse monies earned by "Western Stepp" on January 19, 2024 shall be redistributed in accordance with the official order of finish. In addition to the penalty issued herein, 1/2 multiple medication violation (MMV) points by the Association of Racing Commissioners shall be assigned as a result of this violation. The payment of the fine associated with this ruling must be received by the New Jersey Racing Commission on or before February 29, 2024. MMV p

POSITIVE TEST- POST RACE

New Jersey Racing Commission (NJRC) licensee Per Engblom was the programmed trainer of the horse "Mon Amour" when he raced in the 6th race at the Meadowlands Racetrack on April 29, 2023 and finished in first place. Following this race, "Mon Amour" was selected to submit post-race blood and urine samples for analysis. A report from Industrial Laboratories identified the presence of Oxycodone, Carisprodol and Meprobamate, a metabolite of Carisprodol. At Mr. Engblom's request, split sample testing was performed at Texas A&M Veterinary Medical Diagnostic Laboratory, which is an approved independent laboratory. These testing results did confirm the presence of Oxycodone, Carisprodol and its metabolite Meprobamate. This is in direct violation of the rules and regulations of the New Jersey Racing Commission. An administrative hearing was conducted on December 6, 2023 in the Judges' office at the Meadowlands Racetrack to accept evidence and testimony regarding this matter. As a result of this hearing, the Board of Judges have determined that NJRC licensee Per Engblom was the programmed

trainer of the horse "Mon Amour" when he raced in the 6th race at the Meadowlands Racetrack on April 29, 2023 and the presence of these prohibited substances is in direct violation of N.J.A.C. 13:71-23.1, and N.J.A.C. 13:71-23.6. As a trainer licensed by the NJRC, Mr. Engblom is the absolute insurer of and responsible for the condition of a horse within his care and custody and shall not enter or start a horse that has in its body any drug or substance foreign to the natural horse. As a result of the evidence and testimony presented at the administrative hearing held on December 6, 2023 regarding the post-race positive test from the horse "Mon Amour" for the drug Oxycodone on April 29, 2023, Mr. Engblom is hereby issued a full suspension of his NJRC license for a period of one year (365 days). Said suspension shall begin on March 15, 2024 and run through March 14, 2025 inclusive.

Blood sample #913677 collected at Northfield Park on 11/6/23 from the horse Fearthelue was found to contain clenbuterol at a concentration of 1206+-79 picograms per milliliter of plasma. This exceeds the Regulatory Threshold of 25 picograms per milliliter adopted by the OSRC. Mr. Miller had a hearing with the judges on 2/25/24. He is hereby fined \$1000 and suspended for 30 days. Fearthelue is disqualified and as a result of that disqualification all purse money must be returned for redistribution (\$6,000.00). First offense in the last 365 days. If this ruling is not appealed the penalty will be reduced to a fine of \$500 and 15 days suspension and loss of purse. O.S.R.C.-3769-18-01(A)(10)&(13) 18-02 The fine and purse money must be paid by 3/6/24. During his suspension Mr. Miller is barred from all grounds governed by the OSRC. Any horses that he wants to transfer to another owner or trainer must be approved by the judges or OSRC. Mr. Miller has 48 hours to appeal.

Blood samples drawn (post-race) from SOME BET YANKEE were tested and found to contain Boldenone. A split sample was tested by UIC Analytical Forensic Testing Laboratory and the presence of Boldenone was confirmed. Mr. Miller was NOT the trainer of record of SOME BET YANKEE for this qualifier but admitted (while under oath at the trainer's hearing) to administering the Boldenone himself on or about June 11, 2023. Although this admission does not completely absolve the trainer, Amanda Shaw, from responsibility for positive test, it was used to mitigate the penalty she received. Mr. Miller is fined \$2,500 (fines are due within ten days of ruling) and issued a 30-day full suspension (March 5, 2024 up to and including April 3, 2024). Aggravating factors were considered in the determination of this penalty. Appeals are due within ten days of this ruling and must be submitted in writing (accompanied by a \$750 bond) to: The PA State Horse Racing Commission, 2301 N.
