

Pandy's Meadowlands Selections for Saturday, November 30

Note: My odds-line for my top four contenders is based on what I think each horse's chances are to win the race. For instance, if I make a horse 4-1, I think the horse's chances of winning are about 20%, so if the same exact race was run ten times, he'd win it twice. If I make all of the horses about the same odds, that's an indication that I think the race is wide open, or that I can't pinpoint a horse that appears to have a clear edge.

RACE 1

5 LYONS STEEL 6-5
8 PRIMARY COLORS 5-2
3 BIG SKEWY N 9-2
7 MAD MAX HANOVER 8-1

LYONS STEEL closed quickly to beat a better field than this here two back and just missed to a sharp horse in last at Philadelphia...PRIMARY COLORS is third off a short layoff and may be the main rival here.

RACE 2

8 OAKWOOD HEYMIKI IR 8-5
3 NUCLEAR 2-1
4 FOR ONCE INMY LIFE 4-1
7 VANDIEMEN LBLUECHIP 6-1

OAKWOOD HEYMIKI IR by Always B Miki, is two for two in this country for hot barn...NUCLEAR is also by Always Be Miki and he's a pretty fast 3yo; draws inside of main rival and is a threat and what may be a two horse race.

RACE 3

1 ALTA BLUES A 8-5
3 JACK'S LEGEND N 5-2
9 HUNT FOR CASH 3-1
7 LYONS PRIDE 10-1

ALTA BLUES A comes off good efforts behind a sharp repeat winner who was a heavy favorite...JACK'S LEGEND N rallied well into a stepped-up final half in last...HUNT FOR CASH has been racing well and can leave...LYONS PRIDE had no shot from post 7 at Yonkers in his last two starts.

RACE 4

1 BE DAZZLED LOU A 7-2
9 JOEMIKIYOURSOFINE 7-2
7 DA DELIGHTFUL 4-1
3 STONE HANOVER 9-2

BE DAZZLED LOU A has been chasing some sharp horses in PA; tries two turns for the first time and was David Miller's choice over three other horses; edge in a competitive race.

RACE 5

5 CALL ME GOO 7-5
3 M-M'S DREAM 7-2
6 NELSONBRITEAGLE NO 4-1
2 ALLEGIANT 5-1

CALL ME GOO was strong winning the Breeders Crown to add to her laurels, which include 19 wins in her last 29 starts; if she wins this, she goes over \$1 million in earnings...M-M'S DREAM classy mare is quite capable...NELSONBRITEAGLE NO has raced well against the favorite...ALLEGIANT won the 3yo filly pace stylishly; she faces older here.

RACE 6

2 MIKI AND MINNIE 7-5
1 RODEO DRIVE DEO 2-1
5 SIMPLY PERFECT 9-1
9 UNREASONABLE 9-1

MIKI AND MINNIE went a big mile winning the 2yo filly pace in the Breeders Crown...RODEO DRIVE DEO had post 10 and raced gamely behind MIKI AND MINNIE; gets better spot and has a shot...SIMPLY PERFECT was only 2 lengths behind Rodeo Drive Deo in last...UNREASONABLE had an impossible trip in the Breeders Crown Final; she fits here if Zeron can work out a trip from post 9.

RACE 7

8 SUPER CHAPTER 5-2
6 GO DOG GO 8-5
5 MONSERRATE 3-1
4 BLANK 14-1

SUPER CHAPTER has speed to get position for Dunn and is fast enough...GO DOG GO raced gamely behind the classy Maryland in the Breeders Crown Final...MONSERRATE was a solid second behind Maryland in last...BLANK has been going off at long odds but his efforts in the Breeders Crown were pretty good.

RACE 8

6 TWIN B JOE FRESH 1-9
3 GRACE HILL 7-1
1 ROCKET DEO 10-1
2 MY GIRL EJ 10-1

TWIN B JOE FRESH has always been fast but this 4yo version of her is the best yet...GRACE HILL classy veteran will need a big effort to beat the favorite...ROCKET DEO and MY GIRL EJ are sharp 3yo's moving in against older mares.

RACE 9

3 LUNA LOVEGOOD 7-5
8 WHAT A BID HANOVER 7-2
10 CHAMPAGNE PROBLEMS 4-1
6 MISS BELMAR 5-1

LUNA LOVEGOOD was impressive winning her elimination race for the Breeders Crown. In the Final, she broke on the first turn, recovered at the rear, moved up along the inside, angled out in traffic and was moving well late. I thought she had ton of trot and she seems fastest of these...WHAT A BID HANOVER has improved steadily for Svanstedt and with his horses, that often signals that a huge effort is coming...CHAMPAGNE PROBLEMS gets a tough post and Dunn gets off to ride Luna Lovegood, but this classy filly gets another top driver, James McDonald...MISS BELMAR turned in a solid front running effort in the Breeders Crown Final and had a tough trip in last.

RACE 10

6 WINNER'S BET 2-5
1 LOGAN PARK 9-2
4 PERICULUM 9-2
8 IT'S ACADEMIC 10-1

WINNER'S BET comes off another strong performance and shows no signs of letting up.

RACE 11

5 CAPTAIN OPTIMISTIC 7-5
1 PAPIS PISTOL 5-2
7 SWINGTOWN 4-1
6 SUGAR MAN 9-1

CAPTAIN OPTIMISTIC raced well in the Breeders Crown Final and seems best here...PAPIS PISTOL steps up sharp...SWINGTOWN best needed...SUGAR MAN has turned the corner for Pelling; tries tougher.

RACE 12

4 SEVEN COLORS 13-1
1 ABUCKABETT HANOVER 6-5
8 COACH STEFANOS 5-2
10 RUTHLESS HANOVER 7-2

SEVEN COLORS raced well over this track in the Breeders Crown. In his last start at Yonkers, he didn't have a good trip as he got stuck behind weak cover behind a modest pace, rallied three wide on the final turn and finished willingly...ABUCKABETT HANOVER has been sharp all year and is the one to beat...COACH STEFANOS was 10th in the Breeders Crown Final and unleashed a furious well-timed rally to get up for the win; strong closer seems to like this track...RUTHLESS HANOVER classy speedster should be the last one to the lead for Napolitano, Jr. and no one will be surprised if he hangs on.

2 PANETTONE HANOVER 4-1

RACE 14

5 CENTURY KOMODO** 8-5
4 GAITWAY GUY 2-1
3 FRANKIE FRANKIE 3-1
2 ROCK THE BELLES 11-1

CENTURY KOMODO takes a key drop and could go a big mile here...GAITWAY GUY has responded to being put on the lead and looks for his third straight while stepping up in class...FRANKIE FRANKIE rallied to just miss against similar...ROCK THE BELLES tries the big track.
