Note: My odds-line for my top four contenders is based on what I think each horse's chances are to win the race. For instance, if I make a horse 4-1, I think the horse's chances of winning are about 20%, so if the same exact race was run ten times, he'd win it twice. If I make all of the horses about the same odds, that's an indication that I think the race is wide open, or that I can't pinpoint a horse that appears to have a clear edge.

STEVEN'S SALOON has been chasing faster and he might leave here...AYR CORLEON GB fought back nicely to hold the lead in his qualifier and the Irish import lured Bartlett off of three others here. It looks like there's no change of ownership, so the connections think that this gelding can make them some money here; might end up as the favorite...LAZARUS STAR only has 1 win in 28 starts and loses Bartlett to the 6, but comes off two seconds behind winners that would be strong favorites in this field...NOTORIOUS HANOVER grinded first over against a even money dropdown winner in last.

TOCCOA FALLS drops and moves inside, likes this track...DULY RESOLVED ships in in good form, has speed...LABYAD BROS S finished second last week and drops to the level of his last win...TOM SWIFTY drops down and may show more.

PRIMARY COLORS was surprisingly high odds in last but raced okay, as he was shuffled after leaving. Gets Bartlett back in the bike and takes a key drop...IT'S MAHOMES A came back to the races sharp, steps up...IGNATIUS A never got involved in the slop but he's dangerous against this type...JILLIBY DYNAMITE A has been racing well.

SWEET JEFF IR raced well in first start for the Burke barn...DA DELIGHTFUL has dangerous speed at this level...HAGGARD finished gamely from a tough post in last at Freehold; has won at this level here...ON ACCIDENT made up good ground from far back in last; drops.
