TC, along with Michele Kopiec and a host of USTA licensed presiding judges, will serve as instructors in areas including judging responsibilities, communication, accident protocol, the eTrack system and FAS. Lane also mentioned that Ceasars/Hoosier had hosted an extremely successful CE in November of 2024, in which roughly 30 racing officials from several different jurisdictions participated.

• Fairs Committee Update

• Jessica Schroeder provided an update on the USTA Matching Funds Program, which has assisted over 150 fairs and county horsemen's associations since 2006. Originally providing \$10,000 in advertising assistance, the line item was increased to \$20,000 in 2012. The program has morphed over the years to be the new "Fair Assistance Program" to also include Promotional Item Reimbursement and the Bulk Purchasing program.

• Pari-Mutuel Committee Update

• Mark Loewe discussed the implementation of Graded Stakes which is now available in USTA pedigrees for races in the US and Canada.

• <u>Driver/Trainer Committee Update</u>

• Mike and Gail McNeely of VanGundy Insurance Agency, gave an in-depth overview of the disability income program with accidental death and dismemberment as well as Equine liability and mortality written by VanGundy, underwritten by Chubb insurance. There are no rate changes for 2025. As of February 1, 2025, there are 3,686 USTA members eligible for coverage with 122 opting in to the voluntary program – the program continues to struggle. Mike and Gail encourage directors to promote the program to their horsemen, informational pamphlets are available for distribution and a PDF version is available on the USTA website.
