Alagna: “He’s being pointed toward the Cup and the Pace. His qualifier was a sneaky good line. 3	Captain Optimistic (\$454,830 – 1:49)	D. Dunn, N. He trained super last week and is qualifying Friday at The Meadowlands. His big win came in the \$252,000 PaSS final. Burke: “He qualified really well and is going to the sire stakes on Saturday.” Breeding: Papi Rob Hanover-Real Touch Last Race: 4/19/2025 – M1 – Qualifier – 2nd (1:53.1)
5	Papis Pistol (\$184,867 – 1:49.3)	A. Miller, S. DePinto Shannon C. DePinto, Chris Arvanitis, Anthony Perretti, Brad Shackman	Fired his biggest shot of 2024 taking the \$148,500 Kindergarten final in 1:50.3 as the 1-5 favorite. Will qualify Friday at The Meadowlands. DePinto: “He’s coming into the season well. He was turned out on Andy Miller’s farm and has trained down very well. For a smaller stable like mine, it’s an exciting time.” Breeding: Papi Rob Hanover-Bang Bang Last Race: 11/30/2024 – M1 – Governor’s Cup – 4th (1:50.4)
6	American Son	D. Dunn, C. Ryder	Finished second to Pace ineligible Sippinonsearoc in a qualifier last Saturday. Went 4-for-7 during his freshmen season with all of his losses coming to

7	Prince Hal Hanover (\$287,321 – 1:51)	D. Miller, Dr. I. Moore Prince Hal Hanover Stable	Sparkled in his second qualifier at Southern Oaks Training Center, winning in 1:51. Moore: “He was an average colt until May of last year and then he started picking things up. He’s grown tall and filled out. I’m very optimistic. He’s in the sire stakes Saturday at The Meadows. When the sire stakes are over, we’ll go to the Somebeachsomewhere.” Breeding: Captaintreacherous-Percy Bluechip Last Race: 4/16/2025 – SOTC – Qualifier – 1st (1:51)
8	Manolete (\$232,243 – 1:50.4)	S. Zeron, B. Saunders M and L of Delaware LLC, M & M Harness Racing LLC	Off a second-place finish to powerhouse winner Smooth Dream in the Home Grown. Saunders: “He showed advancement [last week]. We didn’t like the fact that we [had to race on the lead], but we’re happy with his progress so far. This weekend [in the Jersey Sire Stakes], he’s in a good spot, and I think he’ll be the favorite in there.” Breeding: Cattlewash-Glancewithme Last Race: 4/26/2025 – M1 – Home Grown – 2nd (1:51.2)
9	D A Love Boat (\$71,589 – 1:48.4)	Y. Gingras, J. Darling Jack Darling Stables Ltd	His last outing of last year was a memorable one, as he took down Louprint in 1:48.4. Darling: “We’re going to qualify Friday at Mohawk. He’s a little bit of an unknown entity but based on his last start at Lexington [last year], he was pretty impressive and it looks like he belonged. He was always a nice colt but I really didn’t expect him to win that race.” Breeding: Captain Crunch-Addicted To Love Last Race: 10/5/2024 – Lex – International Stallion Stakes – 1st (1:48.4)
10	Fusion (\$106,322 – 1:50.4)	T. McCarthy, B. Pelling Diamond Creek Racing	Went 4-for-5 during 2024 racing against Kentucky Commonwealth stock. He hasn’t had the horse long, but the 5-time Meadowlands Pace-winning trainer said that’s no big deal. Pelling: “I’ve had him since Feb. 1. He’s impressive to look at. He’s a big strong, black horse. I’m going to qualify him at Chester on Tuesday and then take him to The Meadowlands and qualify him there. We’re not going to the Cup, so we can space things out.” Breeding: Always B Miki-Pure Country Last Race: 11/30/2024 – M1 – Governor’s Cup – 10th (1:51.4)
