## Pandy's Meadowlands Selections for Saturday, November 15

Note: My odds-line for my top four contenders is based on what I think each horse's chances are to win the race. For instance, if I make a horse 4-1, I think the horse's chances of winning are about 20%, so if the same exact race was run ten times, he'd win it twice. If I make all of the horses about the same odds, that's an indication that I think the race is wide open, or that I can't pinpoint a horse that appears to have a clear edge.

KRONOS S was a game second behind Periculum in his last start...FRENCH WINE was given a perfect drive by red-hot driver Jason Bartlett to win the Breeders Crown Open Trot.

His driver Jason Bartlett is having a sensational year; he's 2<sup>nd</sup> in wins with 713, 1<sup>st</sup> in purse winnings with close to \$15 million, and he's winning at a 30% clip, which is remarkable – this is one of the best year's I've ever seen a driver have...TWIN B SEVEN SINS finished 2<sup>nd</sup> at big odds in the Kindergarten Final; needs one of those patented Scotty Z dream trips.
