

## **Pandy's Meadowlands Selections for Saturday, April 25**

**Note: My odds-line for my top four contenders is based on what I think each horse's chances are to win the race. For instance, if I make a horse 4-1, I think the horse's chances of winning are about 20%, so if the same exact race was run ten times, he'd win it twice. If I make all of the horses about the same odds, that's an indication that I think the race is wide open, or that I can't pinpoint a horse that appears to have a clear edge.**

### **Meadowlands Race Picks by Bob Pandolfo**

#### RACE 1

5 PACK YOUR BAGS 8-5  
8 COLT FOURTY ONE 3-1  
10 SEEUINNASHVILLE A 6-1  
3 ROCKIN ROGER 6-1

PACK YOUR BAGS gets a big driver change to Gingras...COLT FOURTY ONE comes off an improved effort.

#### RACE 2

7 JOHAH 5-2  
4 OUR CORELLI N 3-1  
6 HES A SWEETHEART 7-2  
2 STREAKIN PETE 5-1

#### RACE 3

4 AZRAEL BLUE CHIP 2-5  
3 ROCKNACIOUS 7-2  
2 OBLITERATE 9-1  
6 JUMPIN' JACK DEO 9-1

AZRAEL BLUE CHIP hasn't raced since November but should be ready to handle this type. He won 6 of 8 starts as a two year old including his last 5 races and he has 3 wins over this track...ROCKNACIOUS is the main rival here and like the favorite, he seems well prepped for his 3yo debut. Although he only won 1 of 9 starts last year, he turned in several solid efforts.

#### RACE 4

5 COMPENSATE ME 7-2  
4 MAD RIVER 2-1  
6 MARLBANK ROAD 5-2  
1 STOP THE SHOOTIN 9-2

COMPENSATE ME was shuffled behind a longshot in last and finished well late. There's not much separating the top four contenders here...MAD RIVER rallied wide and finished gamely in last...MARLBANK ROAD was used leaving and held the place...STOP THE SHOOTIN drops and moves inside, should show more.

#### RACE 5

2 CAR KEYS 3-5  
6 SUNNY STATION 4-1  
3 LADYSASSIN 7-1  
5 P A PERFECT 9-1

CAR KEYS was coming on nicely at the end of her two year old season and returns for a good layoff barn...SUNNY STATION only raced three times last year and broke in two of those starts but she finished in :25.1 in her debut and I think there's some talent here; main rival for Pelling.

#### RACE 7

5 SEEYOU AT THEBEACH 4-1  
3 WARRAWEE YANKEE 4-1  
6 MANSERTIVE 5-1  
7 LOUIS LITT N 5-1

SEEYOU AT THEBEACH gets a big driver change...WARRAWEE YANKIEE also picks up a catch driver...MANSERTIVE had no shot in last; drops...LOUIS LITT N left and got parked out from post 9; gets a better post and Dunn may work out a better trip this time.

#### RACE 8

2 BOOKIE J 6-5  
6 BE STING 2-1  
3 THISBEESTINGS DEO 6-1  
5 CALLMEBIGPAPI 8-1

BOOKIE J returned to the races sharp for Ryder...BE STING qualified well edging Bookie J in his qualifier and veteran trainer Joe Holloway often has his horses ready to go...THISBEESTINGS DEO ships in off an improved effort as he broke his maiden in his 10<sup>th</sup> start. This is a step up in class but he could be a late bloomer for Burke.

#### RACE 9

8 SABA ROCK 2-1  
5 CAPTAIN CRUSADER A 4-1  
7 VOUKEFALAS 4-1  
6 WISH YOU WELL 6-1

SABA ROCK raced gamely missing by less than a length in a 1:49 mile in his return and could go a big mile here...CAPTAIN CRUSADER A is third off the bench, gets a better post...VOUKEFALAS was unable to win in 16 starts last year but he was facing some of the fastest pacers in the sport. He has 10 wins over this track and qualified well...WISH YOU WELL hasn't won since 2024 but he's in form now.

6 DANCE PARTNER 10-1

RAILROAD STATION and SUGAR MAN are both making their 4yo returns off good qualifiers.

6 STING GIRL 9-1

6 A LITTLE KICK 5-2  
8 SERGEANT WALT 3-1  
9 STONE COLD SAVAGE 6-1  
7 DANCINMYSOCKS 8-1

RACE 14

3 GAZOO\*\* 5-1  
8 GALANTE A 7-5  
2 SONO CONFUSO 5-1  
1 TRICKY CAPTAIN N 6-1

GAZOO raced well and won at a higher level than this last year and showed improvement with good late pace once clear in his third start of the year last week. Picks up Colin Kelly and has a shot at a price in this Trackmaster Series Final...GALANTE A goes for his third straight. Bartlett stole a slow :28.1 opener last week. He'll probably have to work harder this time but he's clearly the one to beat...SONO CONFUSO left and was used hard to the lead from post 9, held well; chance...TRICKY CAPTAIN N backed out of the pocket last week and driver Dexter Dunn seemed to be protecting him so he may have flipped his palate, although that's just a guess. He's entered right back and he finished 2<sup>nd</sup> in his two prior starts.
