POSITIVE TEST- POST RACE

OSRC 3769-18-01-A(1,4d,10,13,15,16), 3769-18-02, 3769-17-43, 3769-17-30-B. Blood sample #T00333 was tested by Eqias Labs and was found to contain TCO₂, a Class 3 category, at a concentration of 43.3 mmol/L, which exceeds the regulatory threshold of 37 mmol/L adopted by the OSRC. Blood sample #T00333 was provided by #7 ON Dayboo, who finished 1st in race 7 on 4/27/26 at MVR, and was trained by Ms. Baker. Ms. Baker waived her rights to a hearing. This is Ms. Baker's first medication violation. Ms. Baker is fined \$1000 and given a 30 day full suspension. The penalty will be reduced to a \$1000 fine, a 15 day full suspension (5/12/26-5/26/26), and a return of purse earnings of \$3500, which is to be returned to MVR within 10 days of this ruling to be redistributed accordingly. The fine is also due to the OSRC within 10 days of this ruling. During her suspension, Ms. Baker is denied the use and privileges of all the grounds sanctioned by the OSRC. All horses owned and/or trained by Ms. Baker may only be transferred by permission of the Judges in Ohio. Ms. Baker has 48 hours to appeal this decision to the OSRC.

POSITIVE TEST- POST RACE

Walter Callahan (DHRC License #2369) was the trainer of record of Primo Maschio for the Kevin Lare Stable when Primo Maschio raced (Post Position 8) in the 11th race at Bally's Dover on March 26, 2026. Primo Maschio finished first. Blood and urine were collected from Primo Maschio in the containment area after the race by and under the supervision of DHRC Chief Veterinarian, Dr Claire Wellman. Specimen ID #676757 was safely and securely shipped to Industrial Labs in Denver, CO, and on April 13, 2026, Industrial Labs reported a positive finding that Oxymorphone was present in the urine sample.

Oxymorphone is a Class I drug and is not permitted to be in a horse's system. DHRC licensee, Kevin Lare, requested DHRC staff ship the split sample for confirmatory testing. The split sample was shipped to EQIAS Labs, Lexington, KY, and on May 8, 2026, EQIAS Labs confirmed the presence of oxymorphone in the urine sample. This is Mr. Callahan's third positive test in less than two years and second Class I drug violation in less than one year. For violations of DHRC Rules: 5.3.2 Trainer Responsibility; 5.3.2.2 Prevent Administration; 8.3.2.7 License reinstated after a prior violation involving a class one or two drug; 8.3.2.8 Whenever a trainer is suspended more than once in a two year period, the horse involved may be suspended. The Board of Judges of the Delaware Harness Racing Commission issues Mr. Callahan the following penalty: Suspension of two and one half years; A fine of \$9,500.00. The purse of \$6,650.00 earned by Primo Maschio is to be returned and redistributed. Primo Maschio is suspended from racing for 60 days, beginning May 19, 2026 through July 17, 2026. Primo Maschio can enter on July 18, 2026. Per DHRC 10.2.7.6, all fines and monies to be returned are due within 10 days of this ruling. Any and all transfers of horses that Walter Callahan is listed as the trainer of record must be approved by the DHRC Board of Judges.

The Running Aces security unit provides breath test prior to each racing performance. The testing is performed using a portable Intoximeter breath testing device. The date of the

reported violation was on a qualifier day May 12th, 2026. Driver Scott Cisco tested positive for alcohol with a reading of .016% - Driver Cisco who took breath test a second time registered 0.17%. CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO THE BEST INTEREST OF HORSE RACING

On July 18, 2025, in the barn area at Tioga Downs, licensee Edgar Clarke poured a harmful topical substance over tape, then applied the tape over a light switch in a premeditated effort to discourage someone from turning on the lights, in reckless disregard for the safety of anyone entering the barn. Clarke's intention was to cause physical injury, pain, or discomfort to anyone who removed or touched the tape in order to turn on the lights and therefore touched the substance. Clarke's actions endangered the health and welfare of other individuals, and the substance caused pain and bodily harm to two individuals, including an infant child. Clarke was aware that adults and minors would frequent the barn. Edgar Clarke was interviewed by a Commission Investigator at Tioga Downs on August 10, 2025, and admitted to purposely applying the tape and harmful topical substance to the light switch to discourage another licensee from turning on the lights. Edgar Clarke's actions are considered assault and conduct detrimental to the best interest of racing, and Clarke's experience, character or general fitness in harness racing is therefore inconsistent with the public interest, convenience or necessity, or with the best interests of racing in New York State. Due to the severity of the violation, the Commission hereby revokes Clarke's occupational license(s) beginning October 25, 2025. Clarke is deemed a disqualified person and is hereby ruled off all grounds under the jurisdiction of the New York State Gaming Commission.

Status as of 5/20/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - Respondent received proper notice of, and participated in, a hearing conducted by video conference on February 5, 2026. The hearing was conducted on the grounds set forth in the Notice of Hearing dated November 6, 2025. The Hearing Officer submitted a Hearing Officer Report dated April 24, 2026, (the "Report") to the Commission for deliberation. The Commission met on May 18, 2026, and after consideration and due deliberation of the entire record, adopted the Hearing Officer's findings of facts and conclusions of law in the Report. Therefore, based upon the entire record (including, without limitation, the evidence specifically relied upon by the Hearing Officer), the Report, and the findings and conclusions adopted by the Commission, it is hereby ordered, that Respondent's Commission-issued occupational license is revoked, and Respondent, as a patron or otherwise, is expelled from New York pari-mutuel and harness racing on or off any Commission-licensed race tracks.

This ruling is in abbreviated form, contact the DHRC for complete ruling text On April 20, 2026, Kevin Lare participated in an informational hearing with the DHRC Board of Judges regarding a post-race positive test for Oxymorphone. Walter Callahan (DHRC License #2369) was the trainer of record of Primo Maschio for the Kevin Lare Stable when Primo Maschio raced in the 11th race at Baily's Dover on March 26, 2026. Primo Maschio finished first, blood and urine were collected in the containment area after the race by and under the supervision of DHRC Chief Veterinarian, Dr Claire Wellman. Specimen ID #676757 was safely and securely shipped to Industrial Labs in Denver, CO, and on April 13, 2026, reported a positive finding that Oxymorphone, a Class 1 drug, was present in the urine sample. Per Lare's request, the split sample was sent to EQIAS Labs, which confirmed the presence of oxymorphone in the urine. On January 15, 2026, DHRC Presiding Judge, Robert Corey issued Lare a 3 month, temporary conditional license, and this license was renewed for 3 months on April 19, 2026. Lare signed the temporary conditional license

agreements in January and again in April. In accordance with DHRC Rule 5.1.16 and per the conditions of this license agreement, "if you violate any provision of the DHRC rules and regulations, or the laws and statutes of the state of Delaware, of any other jurisdiction, and/or the United States of America, you may be suspended and may be subject to further disciplinary actions up to and including license revocation." Mr. Lare has violated the terms of his temporary license agreement. As a result, the DHRC Board of Judges revokes Mr. Lare's license and imposes an indefinite suspension. Any and all transfers of horses that Kevin Lare is listed as the trainer of record must be approved by the DHRC Board of Judges.

Mr. Justin Lloyd was the listed trainer of #3 James In Charge A who was in the 2nd race at Oak Grove on 3/30/2026. #3 James In Charge A was 1st and sent to the State Test Barn where sample E620246 was sent to Industrial Laboratories. A report dated 4/15/2026 confirmed sample E620246 had an overage of Albuterol in the urine at 3.85 ng / mL which is over the threshold of 1 ng / mL violating 810 KAR 8:025 Section 2 - 1. Mr. Lloyd hence requested a split sample that was sent to UC Davis on 5/4/2026. Report dated 5/11/2026 from UC Davis confirmed an overage of Albuterol in sample E620246 at a level of 6.3 ng / mL over the allowed 1 ng / mL. Mr. Lloyd was presented with a Hearing Notice to appear before the Board Of Judges of the KHRG on 5/16/2026 at 11:00 AM. After hearing testimony and presented with evidence the Board of Judges of the KHRG do make the following ruling. #3 James In Charge A is hereby disqualified and is 1st Placed 9th and the purse of \$6,000 (Six Thousand Dollars) is ordered to be redistributed. Furthermore Mr. Justin Lloyd is issued a \$1,000 (One Thousand Dollar) Fine and is Fully Suspended for a total of 30 (Thirty) Days from 6/1/2026 – 6/30/2026. Yogi Sheridan was the programmed trainer of the horse "I DREAM OF JEANIE" when she raced in the third race at The Meadowlands Racetrack on February 28, 2026. Following the race, "I DREAM OF JEANIE" was required to submit blood and urine for analysis. A report from Industrial Laboratories identified the presence of 5-Hydroxydantrolene. Mr. Sheridan was offered the opportunity to have the split sample tested and declined. A hearing was held in the judge's office at The Meadowlands Racetrack on April 29, 2026. As a result, Mr. Sheridan is hereby issued a full suspension of his New Jersey Racing Commission license for a period of fifteen (15) days and is fined the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars. Said suspension shall begin on June 6, 2026 and run through June 20, 2026 inclusive. During the period of suspension, Mr. Sheridan is denied access to all grounds that are under the jurisdiction of the New Jersey Racing Commission.
