

Pandy's Meadowlands Selections for Saturday, June 6

Note: My odds-line for my top four contenders is based on what I think each horse's chances are to win the race. For instance, if I make a horse 4-1, I think the horse's chances of winning are about 20%, so if the same exact race was run ten times, he'd win it twice. If I make all of the horses about the same odds, that's an indication that I think the race is wide open, or that I can't pinpoint a horse that appears to have a clear edge.

RACE 1

10 PACK YOUR BAGS 5-1
3 PARKLANE TERROR 5-1
5 THE BIG RAGOO 5-1
8 STONE COLD SAVAGE 5-1

This is a wide open race, and I'm really not sure which horse should be the favorite. PACK YOUR BAGS gets a huge driver change fits well at this level...PARKLANE TERROR raced well from inside posts then had no shot in last...THE BIG RAGOO finished in the money in his last two starts...STONE COLD SAVAGE was beaten at 6/5 odds in last. He has a shot.

RACE 2

2 OLLIE'S ZTAM 4-1
9 LOU'S RODEO 4-1
8 SECRET SOCIETY 6-1
5 SEE YOUR FRIDAY 4-1

There are four of these TRACKMASTER SERIES FINAL's tonight and they came up as competitive races. OLLIE'S ZTAM showed speed from post 9, was shuffled back, rallied nicely late...LOU'S RODEO set the pace and just missed...SECRET SOCIETY was bet down to 2/5 in his first start as a 3yo and was coming on when he broke over a sloppy track. Then he drew post 9 in last and never got into the race. We may find out why he was such a heavy favorite two back...SEE YOUR FRIDAY had god pace on both ends in last.

RACE 3

5 OPULENCE 6-5
8 FRATTINA DIABLO S 5-2

OPULENCE returns with hobbles off and seems improved based on her qualifiers...FRATTINA DIABLO S beat this type in her return two back, then just missed at 3/5 in a PA sire stakes at The Meadows.

RACE 4

8 MY WISH CAME TRUE 3-1

7 MOONWARDS HANOVER 7-1
5 DANCINMYSOCKS 10-1

MY WISH CAME TRUE left and yielded, held the show in last...DISCO DANCER hasn't raced since May 1, at a track in Alberta Canada. His form was good there but it's hard to figure if he's fast enough to beat these since we rarely see shippers from that circuit...MOONWARDS HANOVER is better than last...DANCINMYSOCKS raced well the last time Lauren Tritton was in the bike.

RACE 5

- 4 IDIOSYNCRATIC** 6-1
- 5 CRUNCHY 7-2
- 6 NATIONAL SPORT 4-1
- 8 A LITTLE KICK 5-1

IDIOSYNCRATIC raced okay in his first start off a six week layoff in last. He makes his second start for new barn, he's fast enough to beat these on one of his better races -- has a shot at a price...CRUNCHY holds good form...NATIONAL SPORT raced okay out of the pocket in last...A LITETLE KICK had a tough trip in last; has a shot here.

EFFINGHAM won the last two times he competed at this level...AMERICAN SON raced gamely in his first start of the year then was overmatched in Kentucky and broke in his last two starts; threat on best...CENTURY HEINEKEN was third in a fast race...ALWAYS BE GIBBY needs a trip.

MARCUS SEELSTER rallied to win last, picks up Lauren Tritton and may get some pace in front of him here...LMC PEANUTS WATCHN left sharply, set the pace and just missed in last...SMOOCH IN THE DARK had a tough parked-out trip and held gamely in last...GAZOO may be closing off a heated pace in this competitive FINAL.

- 9 SOUTH BEACH STAR 9-1

SMOOTH DREAM won 9 of 10 starts last year, 8 over this track, and some pretty nice colts. He qualified well for an excellent layoff trainer...ARODA N came over from down under to compete in the Borgata Series at Yonkers but wasn't a factor. This is a softer spot and we should see what he can do.

STOP THE SHOOTIN' saved ground, angled out in the stretch and was moving well late, last quarter in :26.3; upset call...SERIOUSLY HANOVER has some backclass has been showing it with two wins in three starts since shipping in from Canada...CAPTAIN MARVEL dropped down and was an easy winner in last; fits well here...SPY CRAFT missed all of last year. He showed some late spark along the inside in last and that may signal the wake up call.
