

**Pandy's Meadowlands \$0.50 cent Early Pick 4, (15% Takeout, \$50,000 Guaranteed Pool),

2026: 44 Pick Fours, 10 won, 34 lost, minus \$65.95. I hit the Pick 4 Saturday, June 20. It paid \$36.30 but I had it for \$1.50 and a return of \$108.90. I hit the Pick 4 for \$67.30 Friday, May 29. I hit the Pick 4 Friday, May 1, for \$128.45 on a \$48.00 ticket, and I hit it on a \$24.00 ticket Saturday night but it only paid \$10.45. I hit the Pick 4 Friday, April 24 for \$114.45 on a \$27.00 ticket. I hit the Pick 4 Saturday, April 18 for \$57.90. I hit the Pick 4 Saturday, March 21, for \$92.70 on a \$12.00 ticket. I hit the Pick 4 for \$207.75 Saturday, March 7. I hit the Pick 4 for a return of \$126.70 on a \$24.00 ticket Friday, January 23. I hit the Pick 4 for \$115.40 Friday, February 27, but I had it for \$1.00 for a return of \$230.80.

2024: 81 Pick Fours, 12 won, 69 lost, minus \$1070.45.

2023: 80 Pick Fours, 15 won, 65 lost, minus \$716.40.
