REFUSAL TO COOPERATE WITH AUTHORITIES DURING AN INVESTIGATION

On January 22, 2026, the New York State Gaming Commission issued a Subpoena Duces Tecum to Dylan P. Davis. By failing to comply with the Subpoena, Dylan P. Davis is in violation of Commission Rules 4101.24(k) and 4119.7(d) and the occupational licenses/receipts of Dylan P. Davis are hereby suspended indefinitely beginning April 28,

2026, until such time that Dylan P. Davis substantively complies with the Subpoena. While suspended, Dylan P. Davis is deemed a disqualified person and is hereby ruled off all grounds under the jurisdiction of the New York State Gaming Commission. Any ownership or trainer transfers of horses under the care, control, or custody of Dylan P. Davis will not be permitted without the prior approval of the New York State Gaming Commission, Division of Horse Racing.

Status as of 4/21/2026 - Stay - The stay of suspension has been granted until the Commission's decision on the pending adjudication.

On 07/06/2026 at Saratoga Raceway the post race sample #CV3614349 collected from 7th race #1 "CAM AM" trained by Phillip Fluet, was found to contain "METHOCARBAMOL" at a concentration of 24.8 +or- 0.3 ng/ml, this is in excess of the threshold of 1 ng/ml set forth by the NYSGC. Phillip Fluet is fined \$1000.00 and suspended 7 days 09/09/2026 through 09/15/2026. Having appeared before a representative of the New York State Gaming Commission and waiving his right to a formal hearing and his right to appeal the fine and suspension are reduced to \$500.00 and a 3 day suspension (09/09/2026 through 09/11/2026). In addition, "CAN AM" who finished first is disqualified and the purse money won of \$6,500.00 is ordered returned and redistributed. The horse "CAM AM" must provide a negative sample and requalify before being eligible to race (completed). While under suspension Phillip Fluet is a disqualified person and is denied access to all grounds under the jurisdiction of the NYSGC. The transfer of any horses owned by or trained by Phillip Fluet must be approved by the Presiding Judge.

suspension of his occupational license and fined \$1000.00. Suspension beginning 7/28/2026 to 9/25/2026. Further violations of this nature will result in greater penalties. Having requested a hearing on this matter a stay has been granted. Although fine has not.

POSITIVE TEST- POST RACE

Industrial Laboratories reported that sample#E630573 provided by the horse CANIPILOTALL trained by Carrie Hollman following its first-place finish in the sixth (6th) race at the Clinton County Fair (Frankfort) on 7/14/2026 contained Gabapentin, a prohibited substance in accordance with the standard used in Indiana County Fair Races as prescribed by the Indiana Horse Racing Commission Rules, 71 IAC 8-1-4-2. Carrie Hollman, trainer of CANIPILOTALL, was advised of this positive test and of her rights to split sample testing. Mitigating circumstances were considered in determining the appropriate penalty. The judge found that the positive test resulted from inadvertent environmental contamination rather than intentional administration. Hollman provided evidence to show the unintentional transfer of the substance to the horse. Trainer Hollman chose to waive her right to send this sample for split testing. It is hereby ordered that CANIPILOTALL is disqualified and the purse money won is hereby ordered forfeited and redistributed among the remaining horses according to their order of finish.

Christine Holt was the trainer of Record for her horse, He Can Rock, who raced at Bangor Fair on 8/5/26 in race # 7. The Industrial Laboratories of Denver, Colorado, has notified the Maine State Harness Racing Commission that an analysis of blood sample #E718378 taken from the horse, He Can Rock at Bangor Raceway, on August 5, 2026, disclosed an elevated level of 5-Hydroxydantrolene at 807 pg/mL. The elevated level of 5-Hydroxydantrolene is evidence of a violation of Commission Rule Chapter 11; therefore, this finding constitutes a positive test for the horse, He Can Rock. Ms. Holt has agreed to a consent agreement with the MSHRC. Therefore, She has been fined the amount of \$ 500.00 for this violation and ordered to return the purse winnings of \$ 360.00.

FALSIFICATION OF LICENSE APPLICATION

As a result of the administrative hearing conducted on April 25, 2024, in which the purpose was to accept evidence and testimony relating to the license application filed on January 22, 2023 by Greg Peck, the Board of Judges has determined that: New Jersey Racing Commission ("NJRC") applicant Greg Peck did fail to provide truthful, accurate information concerning his prior arrest record on his 2023 NJRC license application. NJRC State investigators furnished evidence of multiple arrest records, both in New Jersey and Pennsylvania, that Mr. Peck failed to disclose in his application. Having considered the evidence and testimony presented at this hearing, the Board of Judges has determined: Mr. Peck, having failed to disclose this information, violated the following NJRC rules; Mr. Peck is in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:71-7.2, N.J.A.C. 13:71-7.3, and N.J.A.C. 13:71-7.7 and, as such, Mr. Peck is suspended for a period of one year (365 days), from Sunday, July 7, 2024 through Sunday, July 6, 2025 inclusive. During the period of suspension, Mr. Peck is denied access to all grounds under the jurisdiction of the NJRC for any and all purposes. Mr. Peck is also fined the sum of two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars. Payment of the fine associated with this ruling shall be received by the NJRC on or before July 6, 2025. Mr. Peck is not currently licensed by the NJRC. As a result, the suspension shall be served as a period of license ineligibility.

Status as of 8/26/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - By Ruling No. 24FRE26, dated May 15, 2024, the Board of Judges found trainer Gregory Peck to be in violation of N.J.A.C. 13:71-7.2, N.J.A.C.13:71-7.3, and N.J.A.C. 13:71-7.7 for failing to provide truthful, accurate information concerning his prior arrest record on his 2023 Commission license application. The Board of Judges issued a license suspension of one year and a fine of \$2,000.00. Mr. Peck appealed the decision of the Board of Judges. A stay was granted by Ruling No. 24TRH18, dated June 5, 2024, and the matter was transmitted to the Office of Administrative Law as a contested case. As a result of a Settlement Agreement, trainer Gregory Peck is hereby fined the sum of \$2,000.00. The one-year suspension will not be enforced. Payment of the fine is due on or before September 30, 2026. Related rulings: 24FRE26, dated May 15, 2024; 24TRH18, dated June 5, 2024.

It was tested by the Ohio Department of Agriculture ATL and was found to contain Flunixin at a concentration of 680.7 +/- 76.1 nanograms per milliliter of plasma. This exceeds the regulatory threshold of 20 nanograms per milliliter adopted by the OSRC. Mr. Schmucker waived his rights to a split sample, DNA, and a hearing. This is Mr. Schmucker's first medication violation in the last 365 days. Mr. Schmucker is hereby fined \$1000 and return of purse.
