Mr. Tony Alagna was the listed trainer of #1 Simply Perfect who was in the 1st race at The Red Mile on 9/26/2024. #1 Simply Perfect was 2nd and sent to the State Test Barn for Post Race Testing. Sample E706531 that was sent to Industrial Laboratories confirmed in the Urine an overage of Albuterol at a level of 32.5 ng/mL which is over the allowed 1 ng/mL violating 810 KAR 8:025. Mr. Alagna did request a split sample that was sent to the University of Kentucky which confirmed a level of 27.296 ng/mL with Certificate Number 0216-2025 which was processed on 3/5/2025. Mr. Alagna was summoned to a hearing before the Board Of Judges on 9/8/2025. After hearing testimony and presented with evidence the Board of Judges hereby issue the following ruling. Mr. Alagna is hereby

issued a 30 (Thirty) Day Suspension that will run from 9/22/2025 ? 10/21/2025 & a Fine of \$1,000 (One Thousand Dollars). The Purse of \$19,375 (Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars) is hereby ordered to be returned within 30 Days of this ruling. During his Suspension Mr. Alagna is not allowed on any racetrack under the jurisdiction and control of the KHRG and any horses owned or trained by Mr. Alagna must require prior approval from the Board of Judges at the Red Mile prior to any and all transfers. Mr. Alagna has been made aware of his rights to an appeal with the KHRG and must submit his appeal and request for stay within 10 days of this ruling to the KHRG President & CEO.

Status as of 9/1/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - Mr. Tony Alagna was the listed trainer of #1 Simply Perfect who was in the 1st race at The Red Mile on 9/26/2024. #1 Simply Perfect was 2nd and sent to the State Test Barn for Post Race Testing. Sample E706531 that was sent to Industrial Laboratories confirmed in the Urine an overage of Albuterol at a level of 32.5 ng/mL which is over the allowed 1 ng/mL violating 810 KAR 8:025 Section 2 - 1. Mr. Alagna did request a split sample that was sent to the University of Kentucky which confirmed a level of 27.296 ng/mL with Certificate Number 0216-2025 which was processed on 3/5/2025. Mr. Alagna was summoned to a hearing before the Board of Judges on 9/8/2025. After hearing testimony and presented with evidence, the Board of Judges issued Ruling RM2025-020 on 9/8/2025. Mr. Alagna was granted a stay during administrative appeal, which has now concluded. The Board of Judges hereby amend Ruling RM2025-020 and reissues it as Ruling RM2025-020 (Amended) to reflect the outcome of the administrative appeal. Mr. Alagna is hereby issued a Thirty (30) Day Full Suspension that will run from 9/11/2026 through 10/10/2026 and a Fine of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars. #1 Simply Perfect is hereby disqualified and the purse of Nineteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Five (\$19,375) Dollars is hereby ordered to be returned to The Red Mile for redistribution within Thirty (30) Days of this ruling. During this suspension, Mr. Alagna is denied privileges and access to all association grounds under the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Horse Racing and Gaming Corporations. Any and all horses owned or trained by Mr. Alagna are not permitted to be transferred without prior approval of the Board of Judges of the KHRG.

All transfers of horses must be approved by the DHRC board of judges. All fines are due within 10 days of this ruling.

Status as of 8/17/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - Having considered the evidence presented it is the decision of the Delaware Harness Racing Commission that, pursuant to DHRC Rule 10.2.9, Mr. Bier is in violation of DHRC Rules 5.3.2 and 8.3.1.2 due to the presence of 3-hydroxylidocaine in LEVI SONIC in excess of a 20 pg/mL threshold following the 8th race on September 22, 2025. Blood sample #930403 collected at Northfield Park on 9/14/25 from the horse Night Shadow was tested by the Ohio Department of Agriculture ATL and was found to contain over the allowable level of furosemide. At a concentration of 140 + - 8 nanograms per milliliter of plasma. This concentration exceeds the regulatory threshold of 100 nanograms per milliliter adopted by the O.S.R.C. Mr. Burke requested a split sample which did confirm over the allowable level of furosemide. Mr. Burke had a hearing via phone with the judges at Northfield Park on 11/23/25. This is Mr. Burke first medication violation in the last 365 days. He is hereby fined \$1000. Night Shadow is disqualified and as a result of that disqualification all purse money must be returned for redistribution (\$10,000.00).if this ruling is not appealed the penalty will be reduced to a \$500 fine and return of purse. O.S.R.C.-3769-18-01 (A) (4b,15,16) 3769-18-02 3769-17-43.The fine and purse must be paid by 12/4/25. Mr. Burke has 48 hours to appeal this ruling to the OSRC.

Status as of 9/1/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - Mr. Burke had a hearing regarding ruling #25NFLD-380 in front of a hearing officer and the ruling was upheld. Full text of the ruling is available from the DHRC. Christine Crissman-Bier was the trainer of Levi Sonic who raced at Harrington Raceway on Sept 22 2025, Sample E609758 was sent to Industrial laboratory, 3 hydroxy lidocaine was confirmed in the blood at 154.5 pg/ml. Upon notification of the results of the test, Ms. Crissman-Bier and Sean Bier requested a split sample. They chose New York Testing and Research, split sample confirmed 3 hydroxy lidocaine in the blood at 123.7 pg/ml Taking into consideration that Ms. Crissman-Bier had a previous class 1 and Sean Bier had a class 1 each within 1 year, now Ms.

Crissman-Bier a class 2, Sean Bier being culpable, this is a violation of DHRC rule 8.3.2.7. Also rules 5.3.2,5.3.2.4,5.3.2.2,8.3,8.31.2,10.2.8.1,10.2.7.6 All purse money must be returned and redistributed. All transfers of horses must be approved by the DHRC board of judges.

Status as of 8/17/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - Having considered the evidence presented it is the decision of the Delaware Harness Racing Commission that Christine Crissman-Bier is in violation of DHRC Rules 5.3.2 and 8.3.1.2 due to the presence of 3-hydroxylidocaine in LEVI SONIC in excess of a 20 pg/mL threshold following the 8th race on September 22, 2025. The following penalties are hereby assessed: a total fine of \$4,500 fine, a 9-month suspension (commencing on January 21, 2026), and forfeiture of the purse for the race, which shall be redistributed. Status as of 9/1/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - Mr. Matthew Rodriguez appeared before the Board of Judges of the KHRG by phone for a hearing after being issued a summarily suspension after violating 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – JJ – 1 and 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – JJ – 2 when hypodermic syringes, needles and injectables were found by an KHRG Investigator during a search of his vehicle on association grounds of The Red Mile on race day 8/24/2026. After being presented with evidence and hearing testimony under oath, the board of judges determine that Mr. Rodriguez did violate 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – JJ – 1, 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – JJ – 2 by possessing syringes, needles, and injectables on association grounds. Actions of this nature violate 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – I, as Mr. Rodriguez purposely violated the rules of the KHRG. Mr. Rodriguez engaged in conduct that is not in the best interest of racing, violating 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – Q. Mr. Rodriguez is hereby issued a Five Thousand (\$5000) Dollar Fine and a One Hundred Eighty (180) Day full suspension from 9/1/2026 through 02/27/2027. Mr. Rodriguez is denied privileges and access to all association grounds under the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Horse Racing and Gaming Corporation. Any and all horses owned and trained by Mr. Rodriguez are not permitted to be transferred without prior approval of the Board of Judges of the KHRG.

Brielle Roman, as trainer of record for the horse "THREE IN HEAVEN A" in the 5th race on 7/12/2026 at Vernon Downs, is issued a Sixty (60) day full suspension of her occupational license, beginning September 11, 2026, through and including November 9, 2026, and a \$1,000 fine. The pre-race blood sample collected from THREE IN HEAVEN A on 7/12/2026 tag number CV3723039 and seal number R2773700 was found to have a TCO2 concentration of 41.1 +/- 0.7 millimoles per liter. The sample was marked as containing Furosemide. This is in excess of levels established by the NYSGC. THREE IN HEAVEN A finished in 2nd place in a field of 7 and \$1875.00 in purse earnings will have to be returned and redistributed. The horse THREE IN HEAVEN A, must re-test at a permissible TCO2 level prior to being declared eligible to race. THREE IN HEAVEN A shall submit to a 6-hour pre-race detention for a period of 6 months, 8/29/2026 through 3/2/2027, without regard as to whether the horse is transferred to a new owner or trainer. The horse must also test in compliance with the above stated rules each time raced during the required pre-race detention period. During the terms of the suspension Brielle Roman is deemed a disqualified person and denied access to all grounds under the supervision of the NYSGC. Any horses owned or trained by Brielle Roman shall be denied the privilege of participating during the suspension unless transferred to another licensee approved by the Presiding Judge. (1st offense in this category). This horse did choose to have a 72-hour guarded quarantine where blood samples were periodically taken for subsequent testing by the commission. As result of such quarantine and samples, lab results showed that this horse is NOT naturally high.

The Indiana Horse Racing Commission received notice from Industrial Laboratories that sample E701140 showed an elevated level of Total Carbon Dioxide at 39.7 mmol/L +/- 2.5 mmol/L. This exceeds the IHRC threshold level of 37.0 mmol/L. As trainer of record, Mr. Stevens-Clemons is in violation of the IHRC trainer responsibility and medication rules. Mr. Stevens-Clemons waived his right to a hearing and accepted the following penalties: A \$500.00 fine A 15-day suspension to be served from September 3, 2026 through September 17, 2026 (inclusive) During the period of this suspension Mr. Stevens-Clemons is denied access to all grounds under the jurisdiction of the Indiana Horse Racing Commission. Any transfer of horses owned or trained by Mr. Stevens-

Clemons shall need to be approved by the judges at Hoosier Park. No purse money to be redistributed as REVELRY finished eighth.
