Mr. Jerry Austin is suspended pending his appearance before the Board of Judges of the KHRG for his pending criminal charges. During this suspension Mr. Austin is denied the privileges of all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Horse Racing and Gaming Corporation. Entry of all horses owned by Jerry Austin is denied pending transfer to the person acceptable to the KHRG Judges.

Status as of 9/9/2026 - Subsequent Ruling - Mr. Jerry Austin appeared via phone before the Board of Judges of the KHRG on 9/9/2026 concerning ruling RM2026-008 where Mr. Austin was summarily suspended concerning his pending criminal charges that occurred on 8/18/2026. After hearing testimony under oath and presented with evidence the Board of Judges do find that Mr. Austin is in violation of 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – C by having pending criminal charges or is criminally charged during his license period, 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – Q by engaging in conduct that is against the best interest of horses racing or compromises the integrity of operations at a track, 810 KAR 3:020 Section 15 – 1 – X – 8 by participating or engaging in conduct of a disorderly nature on association grounds by disturbing the peace. The Board of Judges do hereby issue a Full Suspension from 9/9/2026 through 12/31/2026 at which time during this suspension Mr. Austin is denied privileges of all facilities under the jurisdiction of the Kentucky Horse Racing & Gaming Corporation. Transfer of any and all horses owned by Mr. Austin are denied pending approval to a person acceptable to the Board of Judges of the KHRG.

REDISTRIBUTION**

POSITIVE TEST- POST RACE

Mass 205 CMR 3.29, ARCI. Trainer Todd O`Dea was trainer of record for the horse CASH VAUGHAN, who raced on 08/11/2026 in Race 11 and finished 1st. On 08/26/2026 Industrial Labs reported to the Massachusetts Gaming Commission/Racing Division the post-race analysis of blood sample E735245 taken from the horse CASH VAUGHAN. The adverse analytical finding reported Dexamethasone in blood at 220 pg/mL. The measurement uncertainty of the method is 0.76 pg/mL at the threshold of 5 pg/mL. After being notified of the finding trainer Todd O`Dea waived his right to both a split sample and a formal hearing. As a result of the violation, Mr. O`Dea is hereby fined the sum of \$1,000.00. In addition, the horse CASH VAUGHAN finished 1st and is disqualified and unplaced. The purse monies won or \$4,250.00. is hereby forfeited and ordered returned for redistribution. The fine is payable within 48 hours of imposition. The purse monies forfeited or \$4,250.00 must be returned within 10 days of this ruling or by 09/18/2026.

POSITIVE TEST- POST RACE

Blood sample #938576 collected at Northfield Park on 8/5/26 from the horse Windsong Patriot was found to contain Dexamethasone at a concentration of 19 +/- 3 picograms per milliliter of plasma. This exceeds the regulatory Threshold of 5 picograms per milliliter of plasma adopted by the OSRC. Ms. O`Donnell waived her rights to a split sample, DNA, and

a hearing. This is Ms. O'Donnell's first medication violation in the last 365 days. Ms. O'Donnell is hereby fined \$1000 and return of purse (\$4,400) if not appealed the penalty will be reduced to a \$500 fine and return of purse. O.S.R.C.-3769-18-01(A)(1,10,13,15,16) 3769-18-02 3769-17-43. The fine has been paid. The purse must be paid by 9/17/26.

**POSSESSION OF HYPODERMIC NEEDLES, SYRINGES AND/OR INJECTABLE
AND/OR OTHER DRUGS**

On 08/04/2026, a search was conducted at Saratoga Raceway of the barn occupied by a harness trainer Andrew Sardella (Licensee) by Investigators of the New York State Gaming Commission. Licensee is not a veterinarian or licensed veterinary technician acting under the supervision of a veterinarian with Commission approval. During the search of the barn, the Investigators discovered one syringe with a hypodermic needle attached, three additional needles and a partially used bottle of injectable "PREVAIL" (Flunixin Meglumine Injection), possession of which is in violation of 9 NYCRR § 4120.6(a)(1) and 4120.4. This being Licensee's second offence of this nature, Licensee's harness trainer's license is suspended for 2 years beginning September 15, 2026 through and including September 15, 2028 and Licensee is fined \$5,000. During the period of license suspension, Licensee shall not directly or indirectly participate in pari-mutuel horse racing in New York. Licensee shall be denied the privileges and use of the grounds of all New York racetracks and shall be forbidden from participating in any share of purses won during the period of suspension. Any horse owned or trained by Licensee or by any individual who continues to serve as Licensee's agent or employee during the period of suspension, or for which Licensee directly or indirectly makes any arrangements to care for, train, enter to race, or collect fees or other payments related training or care, shall be denied entry to the grounds of all New York racetracks and shall not participate in pari-mutuel racing in New York.

Status as of 9/9/2026 - Stay - A request for hearing was received from Andrew J. Sardella (Trainer) who was suspended for 732 days and fined \$5000.00 for violation of Commission Rules § 4120.6(a)(1) and 4120.4. The penalty regarded discovering one syringe with a hypodermic needle attached and three additional needles and a partially used bottle of injectable of "Preval" (Flunixin Meglumine Injection) during a

barn search on August 4, 2026. The stay of suspension has been granted but not the fine until the Commission's decision on the pending adjudication.

CONDUCT DETRIMENTAL TO THE BEST INTEREST OF HORSE RACING

Mr. Whittemore was the trainer of record for his horse Vogue Blue Chip, who was scheduled to race at Windsor Fair on 8/31/26. While transporting Vogue Blue Chip to the track that day, an unfortunate accident occurred involving the horse trailer prior to entering the fairgrounds at Windsor Fair. After entering the grounds, Vogue Blue Chip was euthanized by the attending contracted veterinarian. Mr. Whittemore's actions warranted an investigation by the State Steward for the MSHRC. A hearing was held on 8/4/26 at 10:30 AM. After hearing from Mr. Whittemore and receiving statements and investigative information regarding the matter, the judges rendered a decision. The judges found that Mr. Whittemore was in violation of MSHRC rules 7§ 62-2 (Any conduct that is detrimental to the sport), 7§ 62-3 (Any conduct while in the view of the public, which in any way tarnishes the image of the sport.) These are considered level 1 infractions by the MSHRC. Therefore, Mr. Whittemore has been suspended for 1 year, from 9/8/2026 through 9/7/2027, and fined \$1,000.00. This is a full suspension.
